



SP 351 ADVANCED INTENSIVE SPANISH

DESCRIPTION:

This course is taught at Universidad San Francisco de Quito (USFQ). Advanced study of grammar with an emphasis on verb forms. Students will improve oral and written comprehension and communication.

CREDITS: 1 credit

CONTACT HOURS: 15 hours

LANGUAGE OF INSTRUCTION: Spanish

PREREQUISITES: Placement Exam

ADDITIONAL COST: None

METHOD OF PRESENTATION:

Short grammar explanations, class discussion, group work, and activities. Students complete exercises, journals, and readings outside of class.

- Accents.
- Subjunctive mood – nominal clauses, adjective clauses, adverbial clauses, special uses.
- Definite and indefinite articles.
- Simple and compound pronouns.
- Adjectives – qualifying, explicative, specific, superlatives.
- Relative pronouns and cuyo.
- Reflexive verbs.
- Impersonal se and the passive voice.
- Infinitive – uses and meanings.
- Participles and gerunds – uses and meanings.
